

Growing up in a time of uncertainty (the post-9/11 world, economic recession) and changing norms (increased racial diversity, shifting gender roles), Gen Z is mature, self-directed, and resourceful.



Gen Z has higher expectations of information on demand



70% percent of young people displayed symptoms of emotional distress when kept away from their personal dives

Expectation of information on demand

For most information - be it studies, hobbies, products, and careers - the starting and ending points for most Gen Z kids is the internet.



A November 2011 report by Grail Research, suggested kids prefer the digital approach and find it easiest to learn from the Internet

An Emotional Connection with the Digital World

Research study of 800 respondents in the United States and United Kingdom, reported that most of the Gen Z youth attached more importance to digital connections than to money, music and movies.




What would they do if they can't find what they need?

Their mobile devices are an extension of their bodies. They find information fast. They have trusted contacts in their family and closest friends. If they need more information, they may look to unverified rating sites or biased social media in their decision making. They will also ask their hundreds of friends in the social network for advice.
